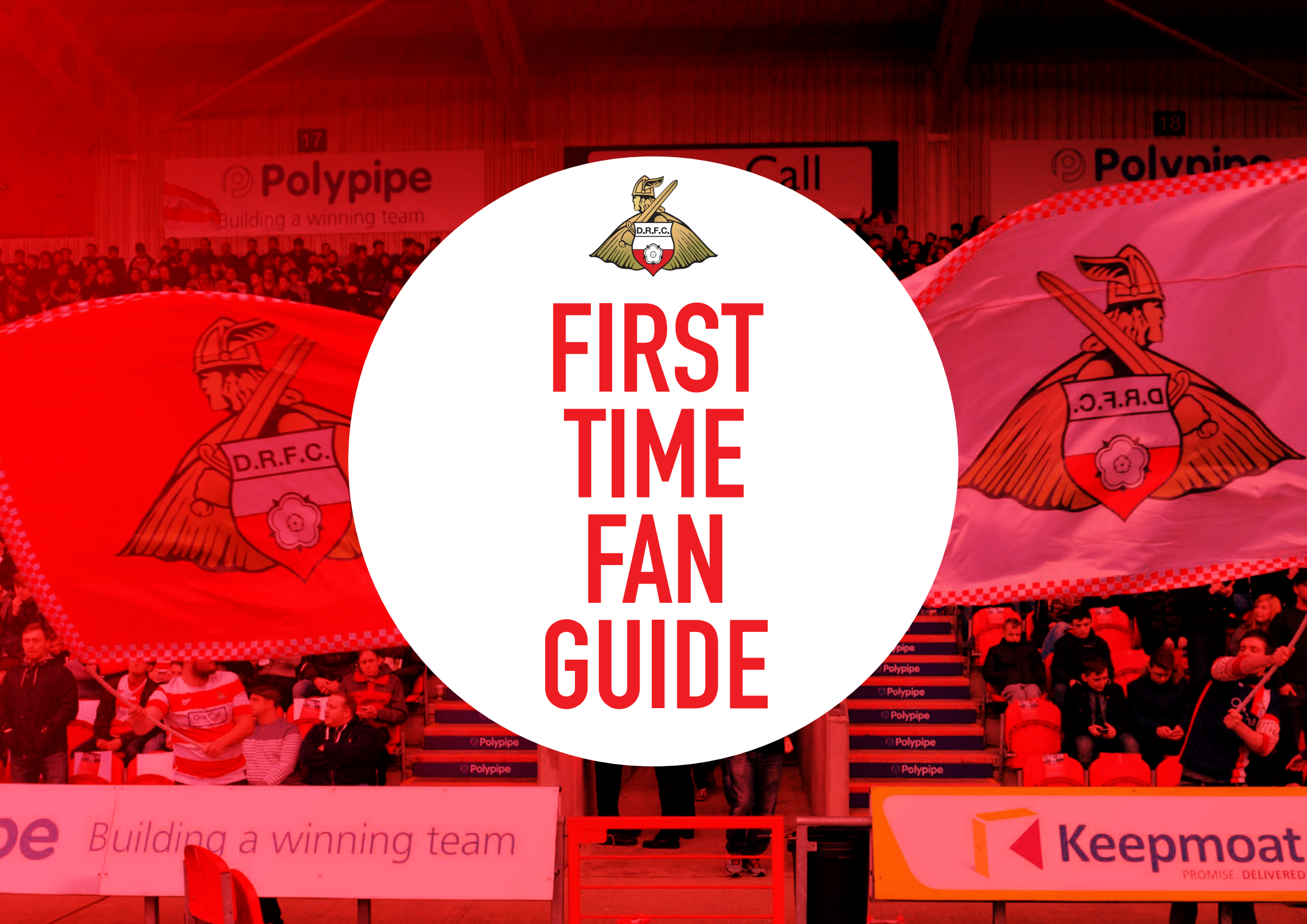

A brief history

Doncaster Rovers played their first game against Rawmarsh on October 3 1879.

In 1885/86 they moved to their first ground and changed the team colours from blue to red.

Rovers first ever league game was played at the Belle Vue in 1923 and remained their home until the move to the Eco-Power Stadium in 2007.

Since moving to the Eco-Power Stadium, Rovers experienced a relative period of success with the team playing in the Championship for the first time since the 1950's.

The club has gone from strength to strength off the field having achieved the Football League Family Excellence Award for ten years running.

Doncaster Rovers offer three easy ways to purchase your tickets. You can buy your tickets in person over the phone or online.

Online -

tickets.clubdoncaster.co.uk. The easiest way for you to purchase your tickets is online.

Tickets will not be sent out by post if purchased within two days of the fixture. If you prefer to collect your tickets in person, the collection point windows are located just to the right of the main reception.

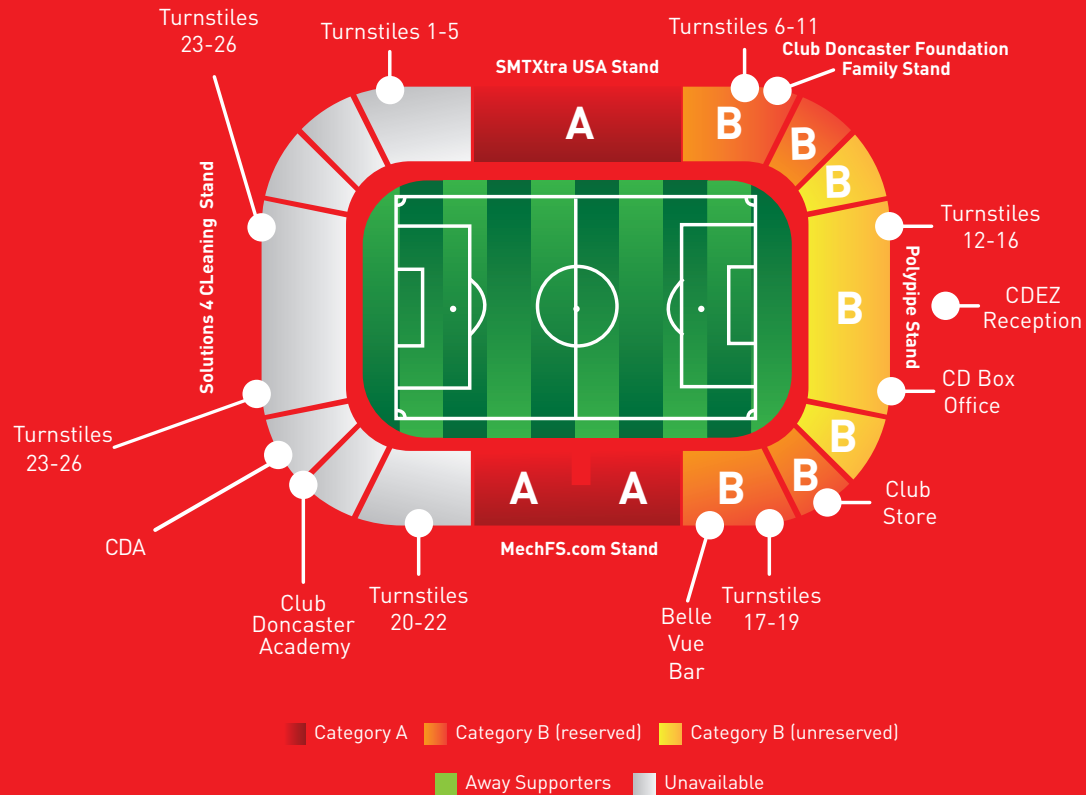

GETTING TO ECO-POWER STADIUM

TRAVELLING BY CAR

From the A1(M) join the M18 Eastbound at Junction 35 (signposted Hull) or from the M1, join the M18 Eastbound at Junction 32. Once on the M18, leave at Junction 3 and take the A6182 towards Doncaster (the stadium is well signposted from Junction 3 and is about 1 and a half miles away).

TRAVELLING BY BUS

For Travel to the Stadium from the Town Centre:

Buses will leave Doncaster Frenchgate Interchange direct to the ground as follows:

- Service 70 at 25, 50 and 55 minutes past each hour
- Service 56 on the hour and 15, 30, 45 minutes past each hour

The journey time is approximately 10 minutes.

For evening events buses will leave Doncaster Frenchgate Interchange direct to the ground as follows:

- Service 70 at 10 and 50 minutes past the hour
- Service 56 on the hour and 15, 30 and 45 minutes past the hour

THE FAMILY EXPERIENCE

The family stand is open from 1:30pm every home matchday (6:15pm for evening kick-offs). The family zone occupies a large section of the East Stand. There is loads of fun and games with Donny Dog getting involved too.

To ensure a family atmosphere, all fans buying tickets within this area must have a junior within their group. Juniors' aged 11 and under can attend the games for only £2.

There is plenty to do with the 'Family Stand Assistants' arranging games, drawing and colouring face painting and much more. Erik the Viking and the famous Donny Dog will be around to challenge you to games and pose for pictures. Look out for activities outside the Family Stand turnstiles on selected dates.





DONNY'S GUIDE TO THE MATCH



Each match lasts 90 minutes
(two halves of 45 minutes)

Doncaster Rovers wear red and white hooped shirts, red shorts and red socks

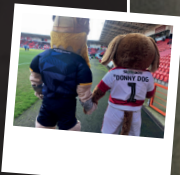


Each team has eleven players

The Belle Vue Bar

The Belle Vue Bar is an external bar situated on the outside of the West Stand and welcomes both home and away supporters.

Live music is played either inside or outside the bar prior to kick-off, with Sky Sports, on the main screens, keeping you up to date with whats happening across the country.

The bar remains open until approximately 45 minutes after the final whistle.
